

# Maxis-Gillet Service Scholarship

Marywood University is rooted in a long-standing tradition of service to local, national, and international communities. Accompanying its commitment to liberal arts education, Marywood strives to prepare students for informed service and progressive leadership in their communities. In addition to providing a variety of service opportunities, Marywood University has chosen to extend this commitment to community involvement through the *Maxis-Gillet Service Award*.

A maximum of twenty **\$2,500 Service Awards** are offered annually to full-time undergraduate students, including up to five first-year students who have demonstrated leadership potential and outstanding service in their communities, and who have a desire to sustain that service and develop their leadership skills while enrolled at Marywood. Candidates for this award must have already applied and been accepted to Marywood University.

Maxis-Gillet Service Scholars are expected to complete a minimum of 215 hours of service during an academic year and to assume team roles in service to both Marywood University and the local community through activities coordinated through Campus Ministry and the Office of Service-Learning and Community Service.

The Maxis-Gillet Service Scholarship is awarded annually through a re-application process, and is renewable for up to four years.
