Introduction

Section Two Executive Summary

Objectives

Alumni post-graduation activities for undergraduate members of the Class of 2015 are demonstrated by categories including full-time employed; full-time employed and in graduate school; part-time employed and in graduate school; part-time employed; in graduate school; unemployed; and, not seeking employment or in graduate school. In addition, graduates are grouped as follows: the proportion of graduates employed in their field of preparation; employed in another field, employed in Pennsylvania, employed outside Pennsylvania. The average salary of full-time employed graduates was \$38,500. Graduates employed, in graduate school or involved in a combination of similar activities was 95%.

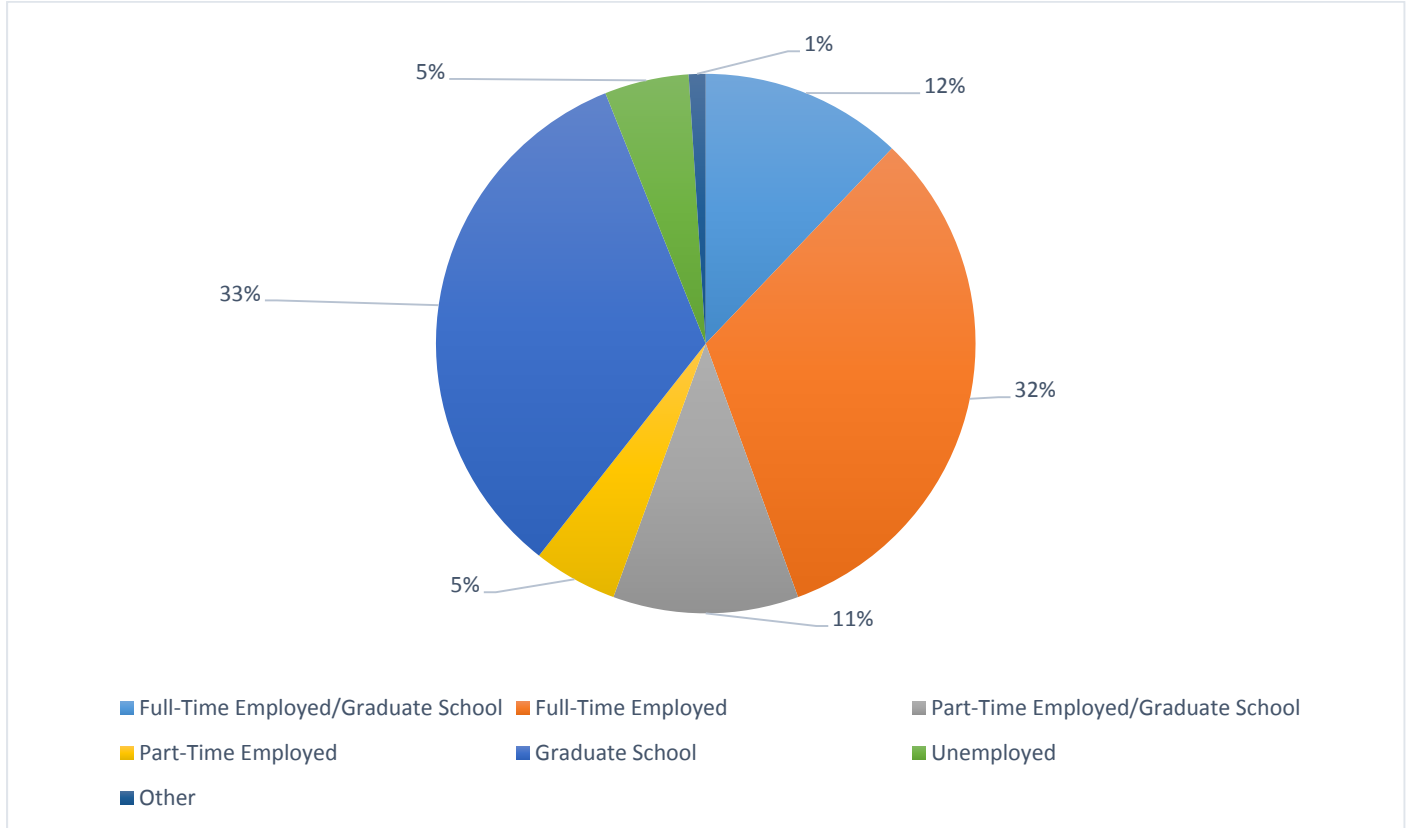
Methodology

All graduates from July 2014 through June 2015 were included in the survey time period. Graduates were emailed a survey link up to six times, dependent upon Career Services receiving a response; those not responding received a mailed paper survey up to two times during this time period. In addition, LinkedIn was used to obtain employment and graduate school attendance data on graduates who did not respond. The knowledge rate obtained for undergraduates was 84% (377 students of 447 graduates).

Undergraduate Alumni Survey Results

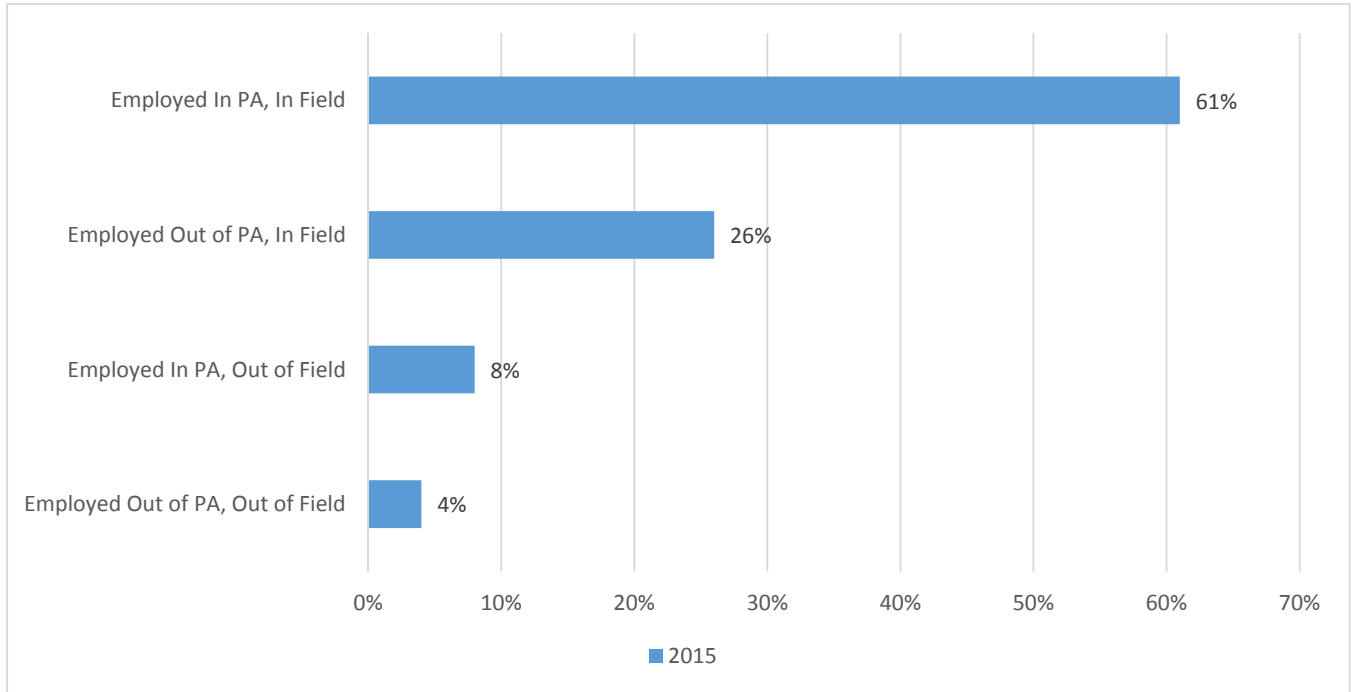


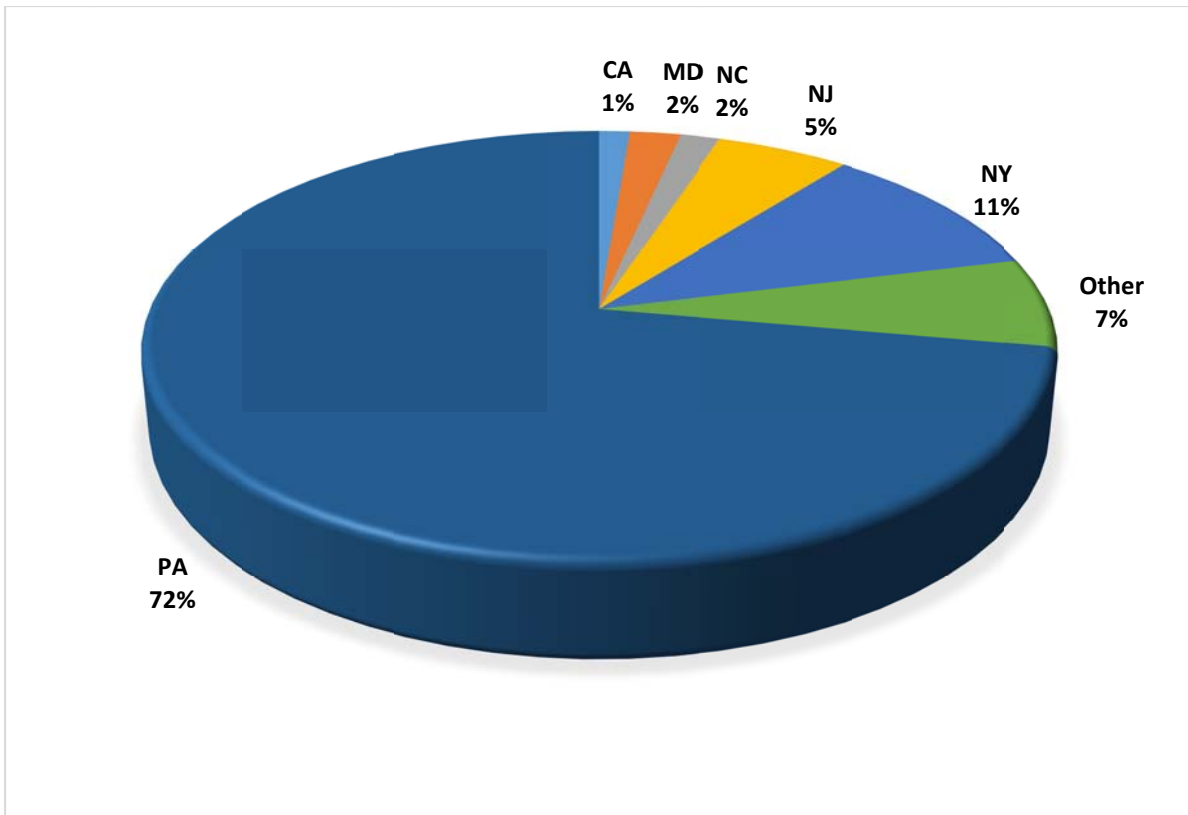

Full-Time Employers of Undergraduate Alumni by Geographic Location

Figure 3 represents the full-time employers of undergraduate alumni by state. 171 full-time alumni are currently working for employers in Pennsylvania, 25 in New York, 13 in NJ, 3 in CA, 5 in MD, and 4 in NC. Meanwhile, 16 alumni are working for employers in other states. These states include Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Idaho, Massachusetts, Missouri, Oklahoma, Utah, Virginia, Vermont, Washington, West Virginia, and Washington D.C.
