Marywood University is located in the northeast region of the United States, in a safe, residential neighborhood of the city of Scranton, Pennsylvania, known for its warm hospitality, affordability, and strong community spirit.

Marywood is easily accessible by automobile, bus, and air, with the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International airport located just a 10-minute ride from campus.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Undergraduate Admissions

- » Complete the online application (Marywood or Common App).
- » Submit official transcripts (with certified English translation if applicable).
- » Provide proof of English proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, or equivalent).
- » Submit one letter of recommendation.
- » Provide a personal statement or essay.
- » Submit a copy of your passport identification page.
- » Financial documentation for I-20 issuance.

Graduate Admissions

- » Complete the online graduate application.
- » Submit official transcripts (with certified English translation if applicable).
- » Proof of English proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, or equivalent).
- » Resume/CV (program-specific).
- » Letters of recommendation (usually 2–3 depending on program).
- » Personal statement or program-specific essay.
- » Copy of passport identification page.
- » Financial documentation for I-20 issuance.
